

This Privacy Policy explains how JLSheridan Law receives and processes personal information as defined by applicable law from its business Clients (“Client Personal Information” or “Client PI”) and visitors (as prospective business Clients) to its website or “Site” (“Visitor Personal Information” or “Visitor PI”). Client PI and Visitor PI may be referred to herein as Personal Information or “PI.”

What Information & Why: JLSheridan Law receives Client Personal Information for the business purposes of legal services to Clients’ businesses (collectively referred to herein as “Services”). Specifically, JLSheridan Law receives or collects the following types of Client PI: First Name and Last Name; and Contact information (E-mail address, physical business address).

With Whom?: JLSheridan Law shares Client PI with trusted Service Providers for the business purposes of providing the Services and may include the following types of services: website management, platform hosting, security monitoring, marketing communications, analytics, and technical support.

Aggregated Information: JLSheridan Law may use aggregated or de-identified information (not containing personal information) (“Aggregated Information”) to analyze trends and improve its Services.

Cookies and other tracking technologies. We do not use cookies or other tracking technologies to collect information.

Compliance with Laws: JLSheridan Law may disclose Client PI to a third party if (a) it believes that such disclosure is reasonably necessary to comply with any applicable law, regulation, legal process or governmental request, or (b) to protect the security or integrity of the Services from harm or illegal activities.

Business Transfers: JLSheridan Law may share or transfer Client PI in connection with, any merger, sale of JLSheridan Law assets, financing, or acquisition of all or a portion of the business to another company. JLSheridan Law may share or transfer Aggregated Information to affiliate or related companies for its business purposes.

California Residents: JLSheridan Law does not sell or share Client PI as defined under CCPA. JLSheridan Law upholds the right of non-discrimination as defined under CCPA.

Nevada Residents: JLSheridan Law does not sell Client PI as defined by Section 1.6 of Chapter 603A of the Nevada Revised Statutes.

Retention Policy: JLSheridan Law retains Client PI as long as necessary to provide the Services unless a longer period is required to permitted for legal or compliance purposes.

Do Not Track: Some browsers offer a “do not track” (“DNT”) option. JLSheridan Law does not respond to DNT signals.

Security: JLSheridan Law employs industry standard organizational, technical, administrative and technological measures that are reasonably designed to help protect information from loss, misuse, unauthorized access, disclosure, alteration or destruction. While JLSheridan Law takes reasonable efforts to guard information, no security system is impenetrable.

Policy On Information Collected From Children:

This Site and Services are not directed at children under the age of 13. JLSheridan Law does not knowingly collect Client PI from children under the age of 13.

Changes:

JLSheridan Law may need to update this Privacy Policy from time to time to reflect changes to its Services and the laws applicable to its provision of the Services. If JLSheridan Law does change this Privacy Policy, it will revise the “Last Updated” date at the top of this Privacy Policy on the Site. Continued use of this Site or the Services after the posting of such notice will be subject to the terms of the then-current Privacy Policy.
